The Giving Tree by Shel Silverstein

Character Trait: Kindness Small group: Gratitude

Grades: K-2nd

Time: 30 minutes

Materials:

The Giving Tree Book

Piece of butcher paper with outline of tree

Fall leaves cut out in different fall colors (1 per student)

Marker & Glue

Lesson:

- 1. Tell the students you are going to read a book by a well-known author about friendship & kindness.
- 2. Read <u>The Giving Tree</u>. While reading, stop and point out the different things the tree gives the boy.
- 3. Ask the students what the boy gives? Explain that everyone has gifts that they have to give. These gifts don't cost anything but can mean so much to others.
- 4. K-2nd Pass out a leaf to each student. Tell them to be thinking about what gift they have to give. Each student has more than one gift so no gift may be written twice.
- 5. Call students up one at a time to share their gift. Write it on a leaf and glue it to the Giving Tree. Display the tree in the hall or classroom where students can be reminded the importance of kindness.
