Lesson:

- 1. Ask the students what they know about a volcano. Discuss how they are also unpredictable. Tell the students often when you interrupt someone it is similar to a volcano erupting and you are going to read them a story about a little boy that struggled with interrupting.
- 2. Read My Mouth is a Volcano.
- 3. Discuss examples of times that they may have been interrupted. Ask for ideas of what they can do if they think of something they want to say when someone else is talking.
- 4. K-2nd- Show students the worksheet. Have them draw a picture of what they can do instead of interrupting. Put it together to create a class book to add to the class library.
- 5. 3rd-4th- Have students write about what they can do instead of interrupting. Put the pages together to create a class book to add to the class library.
